This May the pavilion and the area around the pavilion will be inaccessible due to construction vehicles and materials being delivered. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause

The works will commence in full after Music in the Park on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June with the changing rooms being completely refurbished and enlarged, the toilets being revamped and an extension being created for the referees and officials to change along with a new disabled toilet facility.

These new modern facilities will encourage new users and allow the recreation ground to host youth and ladies football, as well as ensure the future for Mid Sussex Premier League football at the venue.
